The ushers used novelty colour dusters to guide the guests to the evening reception at "Crutched Friars", where the 'quirky' evening theme was introduced. We took the concept of the couples' initials "RC/DC" and adapted this from the band "AC/DC" using "RC/DC" as a logo on bar mats, caps and branded key rings as favours for the guests. This theme was also replicated throughout the invites and RSVPs. A ukulele band that are friends of the groom, provided music for the first part of the evening with the DJ taking the party into the early hours.
